Click and drag the disc drive icon from the desktop into the trash bin. Eject from Context Menu. Hold down the Control button on your keyboard and click the disc drive icon on the desktop. Select Eject from the context menu. Eject from Finder. Launch Finder.

Shut down the Mac. Boot the machine holding down the Trackpad button to initiate a 'force eject'. Turn the MacBook Pro on its side, with the CD/DVD drive pointing down, and shake, the CD should pop out. The disc is still stuck!

Hold the button down until the desktop appears. This will trigger the system to eject your disc before OS X begins loading. Shut down the Mac and restart it, then let it sit for 15 minutes. Insert it carefully into the opening of the optical drive until it touches the disk for a few seconds and stops the CD/DVD from reading it. Then press the eject button continuously. If that doesn't work, tilt the MacBook to a 45 degree angle in a way that the opening of optical drive faces downwards, and then press the eject button continuously.

The Payoff Do a hard restart. Then click and hold down the mouse button while the system boots up. Continue to hold down the mouse button until the CD ejects.

Method # 1: Use the Eject Button It is the easiest and simplest method of ejecting the DVD tray. For doing this, you just need to locate the eject button which is most likely to be present on your DVD tray or towards either of its sides.
