They're literally measurements for patients in the form of volume intake and what they put out, whether that's a drain or weather they're eliminating it.. I&Os also identify a patient's risk for having extra fluid or not having enough fluid.

A fluid balance chartis used to document a patient's fluid input and output within a 24-hour period. This information is used to inform clinical decisions (such as medication and surgical interventions) from medical staff, nurses and dieticians, who all expect accurate figures in exact measurements (Georgiades 2016).
